#### **Other Business/upcoming events:**

Ms. Noce will be back on Dec 2nd

Terra Cotta cookie sales are moving slowly. 3 reminders sent already. Posters printed and hung in school. Teachers will post on google classroom. Another reminder email to be sent.

Voice of concern raised around excessive TV watching during lunch time mainly for FDKs and primaries. Questioning the reason behind that, who is responsible for this, and a call for possible other interactive activities for students to use during indoor lunches. (Raised by Stephen Defrenza and Xinmei Wang)

Ms. Moran explains that it is not a lack of lunch monitors or supervision, but rather up to the classroom teacher's discretion based on the weather, and it's best to talk to the teacher about that.

- A discussion about having 2 outdoor recesses rather than one outdoor recess came up by Natalya. Anette supported the idea. This subject will be brought up with Ms Noce. There is no board recess mandate for a certain limit of outdoor recesses. DPA- Daily Physical Activity should be 20 min. The only issue with multiple outdoor recesses is managing the time to avoid overlapping or division's recesses for injuries and accidents avoidance.
- □ Rebecca addresses an issue about a tree in front of the FDK yard that stinks. It smells and makes fruit that causes this ugly odor. The office will check with Mr. Allen if the fruits can be Shaken off and picked and thrown to avoid the ugly smell. Also, the office will check with the board to find a solution.
- Reminder to look for vendors for the Easter lilies and tulips fundraiser. Violet has a source that she will check.

- ☐ Grades 1-3 can play soccer in the field but not on the pavements. Jennifer had a safety concern issue raised. Ms. Lauren explained that soccer is only allowed on the field and American football is not allowed at all at STM.
